Thank you for giving us the opportunity to care for your pet while you are away.

Our outdoor runs are washed several times a day with a mild disinfectant in accordance with state regulations. Therefore, one must expect a dog to get its feet and undercarriage wet. We will do our utmost to return your pet to you in a presentable fashion. We reserve the right to bathe any animal that soils itself. We reserve the right to decline bathing to any animal that is fractious. We offer complimentary baths to dogs within a certain weight range and who stay a designated number of nights. A comp bath is a basic bath using a gentle hypo-allergenic shampoo, it does not include brushing out hair coats for an extended period of time nor does it include toe nail trims.

Dogs: 1 to 30 lbs. receive a complimentary bath if they stay a minimum of 3 nights.

Dogs: 31 to 50 lbs receive a complimentary bath if they stay a minimum of 4 nights.

Dogs: 51 to 100 lbs receive a complimentary bath if they stay a minimum of 5 nights.

If your pet's visit falls short of the required number of nights to receive a comp bath, but stays a minimum of 3 nights, we are pleased to offer a discounted bath rate of \$22.00 per animal. Most people tend to select this option as they like having their dog bathed before going home.

Cats: We do not offer a complimentary bath to cats as their grooming habits are entirely different than dogs.

CHECK OUT TIMES: All boarding animals must be picked up by 12:00 noon unless prearranged services have been scheduled. Otherwise you will be charged for additional boarding.

We recommend you not leave any collars, toys, bowls or blankets at the hospital. We will not be responsible for any items lost, stolen or damaged. Boarding rates may change at any time without notice, please confirm rate at time of boarding.

Payment for all services rendered is due at the time of discharge and must be paid in full.

For the safety of your pet and the safety of others, we do not allow medications to be placed inside of pre-set meals made by owners for their pet. All medications must be labeled and stored in a separate location in our hospital. Please tell the receptionists if your pet has any medications they need or if you have brought any medications with you at the time of drop off. **Do you understand our boarding medications policy? Yes No**

If your pet is free fed at home, a doctor will determine an appropriate amount for your pet to be fed at each feeding time while boarding with us. This will allow us to ensure that your pet is eating adequately during each offered meal and help us monitor their appetite more precisely during their stay with us.

**** Due to the recent outbreaks of Canine Influenza Virus, we are now requiring this vaccination for all of our boarders starting 1/29/18. If your dog has been examined in the past 12 months and has not been vaccinated against Influenza Virus, we will vaccinate the day that you drop off. It is required that you follow up for a booster vaccination in 3**

weeks after the initial vaccine. It is then an annual vaccination. Each vaccination is \$34.00. This is for the protection of your pet and all of our visiting patients at Arguello Pet Hospital. Please ask our front office staff if you have any further questions.
